

Policy on Compensation

The New York Chapter is one of the Chapters of the Adirondack Mountain Club (Main Club) and is a New York State Non-for-Profit 501(C)7 Corporation. The New York Chapter operates as a volunteer organization, without any paid staff. Although the New York State Non-Profit Corporation law (Section 58, paragraph b) states: “*A corporation may pay compensation in a reasonable amount to members, directors, or officers, for services rendered,*” it shall be the policy of the New York Chapter that no member of the Board of Directors, no Committee member, and no Chapter member, shall receive compensation for the performance of their roles and duties, or services rendered, on behalf of the Chapter. (Ordinary and expected/approved expenses will be reimbursed, as per the Policy on Reimbursement of Expenses)
