

## Policy on Re-instatement of Lapsed Membership

As, according to the New York Chapter Bylaws, *“Termination of Club membership terminates membership in the Chapter and in the Corporation, including Camp Nawakwa. In accordance with Club policy, a person who fails to pay membership fees and dues is no longer a member and also loses all rights of membership including Camp access privileges”*. – Article III, Section 6 (NY Chapter Bylaws) and

As the Main Club has a policy of sending out reminder notices of lapsed membership for a period of ninety days, therefore

The following will be the policy of the New York Chapter regarding any Key-holder who has failed “to pay membership fees and dues” and as a result “is no longer a member and also loses all rights of membership including Camp access and privileges”:

1. If an individual’s ADK membership has lapsed and this individual appears at camp during this period, the lapsed Key-holder is a guest and must pay guest fees, as well as rejoin ADK before revisiting camp.
2. If the individual renews membership before the lapse of 90 days, that individual is re-admitted to the New York Chapter with all rights, including Camp access and privileges, without any penalty.
3. If a lapsed individual renews membership after 90 days, but prior to one year, that individual must pay a \$25 re-instatement fee and participate in either a Fall or Spring Work Weekend or participate in a published Trail Maintenance activity. The leader of the work-event will certify to the Board the individual has fulfilled this activity.
4. If the lapsed Key-holder renews after a year of lapsed membership, the individual must reapply as an Applicant.

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
